

Corona virus advice for allotments. Reminder

Why are we reminding you about steps to take when going to your plot?

23rd April: 2250 people have tested positive in Glasgow, over 1100 people in Scotland have died of COVID 19.

Please observe these simple precautions. *You* may be prepared to take a risk but *you* endanger other members lives

It is essential that no un-authorized people (i.e. non-members) are allowed onto the plots for the duration of this emergency, In exceptional circumstances you may ask someone to assist with work on the plot: please ensure that that this is notified to the committee. *Failure to do so may invalidate our public liability insurance.*

Take care when opening or closing locks and water taps: use a paper towel or a tissue and dispose of it safely.

Wash hands when you get home

Observe "Social Distancing" with each other (2-3 metres) and do not gather together in groups.

Make sure your seating area is *at least two metres* off the main paths

If you take children to the plot, ensure that they stay within its confines at all times and do not run around on communal paths and spaces.

Do not go onto other plots.

Do not share tools

Do not use communal sheds, remove your tools and store them on your plot

Do not have bonfires, it damages air quality. With corona virus people struggle to breathe.
